The Band was formed in 1971 as part of the Company's Social Club and was originally intended to cover all aspects of music from jazz to classical but very soon it was apparent that since most of the members were brass players it would be wise to create a brass band.

During the 70s and early '80s the Band was in constant demand playing in the local area helping charities to raise money and playing for the Company's various social activities.

The latter part of the '80s was very exciting period when the Band registered for brass band contests and was very soon winning prizes, being promoted from the 4th to 1st Section. The Band represented the Southern Area at the National Finals in London and during this time the first overseas tour was undertaken visiting Belgium, Holland and Germany.

There was also a broadcast on Radio Kent and the Band made its first professional recording. Recently the Band has been privileged to take part in a joint concert with the Choir of Canterbury Cathedral in that magnificent building and the members are now preparing for a Continental tour in 1996.
